

Dimitrios Komilis has been a faculty member at the Department of Environmental Engineering of the Democritus University of Thrace since 2005 and a full Professor since 2018. He earned a B.Sc. in Environmental Sciences from the University of the Aegean in 1992, and M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Wisconsin-Madison (USA) in 1995 and 1999, respectively. Dimitrios's main research interests focus on all aspects of solid waste management, including solid waste characterization and valorization, composting and anaerobic digestion, and municipal solid wastes. He has published > 95 SCI journal articles, which have been cited more than 2500 times, and currently has an h-index of 28. He teaches undergraduate and graduate classes of Solid Waste Management, with emphasis on circular economy aspects, as well as Applied Statistics and has written two text books (in Greek) on the above two topics. He is the Head of the Laboratory of Solid and Hazardous Waste Management at the Dept. of Environmental Engineering in D.U.Th. and a coordinator of a graduate course on solid waste management at the Hellenic Open University since 2013. He is a co-Editor in Chief of the Waste Management journal (Elsevier) since 2021.
