Fahrenheit Scholarship

The City of Gdańsk has actively supported the scientific development of young talents for many years. In 2005, upon the initiative of the then Mayor of Gdańsk, Paweł Adamowicz, the first scholarship was funded in Poland to finance studies abroad for the most outstanding Polish and International Baccalaureate graduates. Thanks to the scholarship, the most gifted upper-secondary school graduates who are permanent residents of Gdańsk can undertake studies at prestigious universities all over the world, at which they achieve the best results and become the ambassadors of their home city abroad. In 2022, the scholarship programme was extended to include a new module - scholarships for international PhD students.
